This shoot is registered with the NSSA. All events will be conducted in accordance with NSSA and MSSA regulations. Entry includes all fees. Registered referees will be used and their decisions will be final.

It is the sole responsibility of the shooter to verify shooting classes. A shooter in the wrong class (not corrected prior to an event) will forfeit all awards, purse and options monies. Shooters are required to be present at least 30 minutes before flight times. Management reserves the right to accept or reject any entry, and to change or alter this program as it deems necessary.

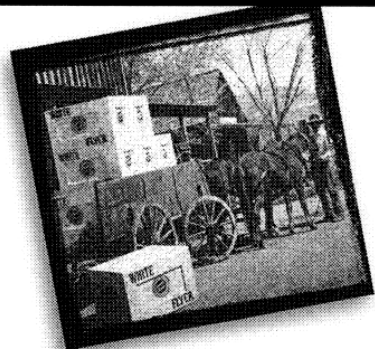
Contestants will not be permitted in the trap houses except by direct permission of the referee.

Champion, Runner-Up and Class 1st will be decided by shooting doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5, miss and out by station. Class 2nd & 3rd will be decided by long run, front or back. Concurrent events will be shot off with the main event, when possible. Shoot-offs will begin promptly after the completion of the 4:30PM flight (approximately 6:00PM). All Orange White Flyer Targets will be used for all events (including shoot-offs). Contestants will supply their own shoot-off shells. Contestants not available for shoot-offs will forfeit their claims.

Shells will be on sale at the club house. Reloads will be permitted. Shooters and spectators assume all responsibility for accidents, theft and loss of equipment.

All deposits will be forfeited if not cancelled 5 days before the shoot; no refunds will be given once registered.
